RESPONSIVE READING August 12, 2019 Psalms 27:1-14 Youth Usher's Penny Drive

<u>LEADER</u>: ⁽¹⁾ The LORD is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? the LORD is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid? <u>CONGREGATION</u>: ⁽²⁾ When the wicked, even mine enemies and my foes, came upon me to eat up my flesh, they stumbled and fell. <u>LEADER</u>: ⁽³⁾ Though an host should encamp against me, my heart shall not fear: though war should rise against me, in this will I be confident.
