1 John 4:1-11

Leader: (1) Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world.

Congregation: (2) Hereby know ye the Spirit of God: Every spirit that confesseth that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is of God:

Leader: (3) And every spirit that confesseth not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is not of God: and this is that spirit of antichrist, whereof ye have heard that it should come; and even now already is it in the world.

Congregation: (4) Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world.

Leader: (5) They are of the world: therefore speak they of the world, and the world heareth them.

Congregation: (6) We are of God: he that knoweth God heareth us; he that is not of God heareth not us. Hereby know we the spirit of truth, and the spirit of error.

Leader: (7) Beloved, let us love one another: for love is of God; and every one that loveth is born of God, and knoweth God.

Congregation: (8) He that loveth not knoweth not God; for God is love.

Leader: (9) In this was manifested the love of God toward us, because that God sent his only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through him.

Ephesians 6:1-9

Leader: (1) Children, obey your parents in the Lord: for this is right.

Congregation: (2) Honour thy father and mother; which is the first commandment with promise;

Leader: (3) That it may be well with thee, and thou mayest live long on the earth.

Congregation: (4) And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.

Leader: (5) Servants, be obedient to them that are your masters according to the flesh, with fear and trembling, in singleness of your heart, as unto Christ;

Leader: (7) For my mouth shall speak truth; and wickedness is an abomination to my lips.
