1 Corinthians 11:23-30

Leader: (23) For I have received of the Lord that which also I delivered unto you, that the Lord Jesus the same night in which he was betrayed took bread:

Congregation: (24) And when he had given thanks, he brake it, and said, Take, eat: this is my body, which is broken for you: this do in remembrance of me.

Leader: (25) After the same manner also he took the cup, when he had supped, saying, this cup is the new testament in my blood: this do ye, as oft as ye drink it, in remembrance of me.

Congregation: (26) For as often as ye eat this bread, and drink this cup, ye do shew the Lord's death till he come.

Leader: (27) Wherefore whosoever shall eat this bread, and drink this cup of the Lord, unworthily, shall be guilty of the body and blood of the Lord.

Congregation: (28) But let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of that bread, and drink of that cup.

Leader: (29) For he that eateth and drinketh unworthily, eateth and drinketh damnation to himself, not discerning the Lord's body.

All: (30) For this cause many are weak and sickly among you, and many sleep.

Joshua 1:1-9

Leader: (1) Now after the death of Moses the servant of the LORD it came to pass, that the LORD spake unto Joshua the son of Nun, Moses' minister, saying,

Congregation: (2) Moses my servant is dead; now therefore arise, go over this Jordan, thou, and all this people, unto the land which I do give to them, even to the children of Israel.

Leader: (3) Every place that the sole of your foot shall tread upon, that have I given unto you, as I said unto Moses.

Congregation: (4) From the wilderness and this Lebanon even unto the great river, the river Euphrates, all the land of the Hittites, and unto the great sea toward the going down of the sun, shall be your coast.

Leader: (5) There shall not any man be able to stand before thee all the days of thy life: as I was with Moses, so I will be with thee: I will not fail thee, nor forsake thee.

Congregation: (6) Be strong and of a good courage: for unto this people shalt thou divide for an inheritance the land, which I sware unto their fathers to give them.

Leader: (7) Only be thou strong and very courageous, that thou mayest observe to do according to all the law, which Moses my servant commanded thee: turn not from it to the right hand or to the left, that thou mayest prosper withersoever thou goest.

Congregation: (8) This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night, that thou mayest observe to do according to all that is written therein: for then thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have good success.

All: (9) Have not I commanded thee? Be strong and of a good courage; be not afraid, neither be thou dismayed: for the LORD thy God is with thee whithersoever thou goest.

Proverbs 9:1-9

Leader: (1) Wisdom hath builded her house, she hath hewn out her seven pillars:

Congregation: (2) She hath killed her beasts; she hath mingled her wine; she hath also furnished her table.

Leader: (3) She hath sent forth her maidens: she crieth upon the highest places of the city,

Congregation: (4) Whoso is simple, let him turn in hither: as for him that wanteth understanding, she saith to him,

Leader: (5) Come, eat of my bread, and drink of the wine which I have mingled.

Congregation: (6) Forsake the foolish, and live; and go in the way of understanding.

Leader: (7) He that reproveth a scorner getteth to himself shame: and he that rebuketh a wicked man getteth himself a blot.

Congregation: (8) Reprove not a scorner, lest he hate thee: rebuke a wise man, and he will love thee.

All: (9) Give instruction to a wise man, and he will be yet wiser: teach a just man, and he will increase in learning.

Jeremiah 17:9-18

Leader: (9) The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked: who can know it?

Congregation: (10) I the LORD search the heart, I try the reins, even to give every man according to his ways, and according to the fruit of his doings.

Leader: (11) As the partridge sitteth on eggs, and hatcheth them not; so he that getteth riches, and not by right, shall leave them in the midst of his days, and at his end shall be a fool.

Congregation: (12) A glorious high throne from the beginning is the place of our sanctuary.

Leader: (13) O LORD, the hope of Israel, all that forsake thee shall be ashamed, and they that depart from me shall be written in the earth, because they have forsaken the LORD, the fountain of living waters.

Congregation: (14) Heal me, O LORD, and I shall be healed; save me, and I shall be saved: for thou art my praise.

Leader: (15) Behold, they say unto me, Where is the word of the LORD? let it come now.

Congregation: (16) As for me, I have not hastened from being a pastor to follow thee: neither have I desired the woeful day; thou knowest: that which came out of my lips was right before thee.

Leader: (17) Be not a terror unto me: thou art my hope in the day of evil.

All: (18) Let them be confounded that persecute me, but let not me be confounded: let them be dismayed, but let not me be dismayed: bring upon them the day of evil, and destroy them with double destruction.
